

USA No-Sew Room Banner

Materials needed:

1 yard of V.I.P.™ By Cranston fabric for the base of the banner

2 colors of coordinating V.I.P.™ By Cranston fabric for stars and letters

2 yards of 17" wide Heat n Bond Iron-On Adhesive

18" length of 1/2" dowel rod

Hot glue and gun

White paint

Scissors

Ruler

Iron



- 1) Cut a 17" x 30" piece of Heat n Bond. Follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse it to the back of the base fabric. Lay another piece of the same fabric on top, wrong sides together and fuse together. Trim any excess fabric around the edges to end up with a double sided piece of fabric measuring 17" x 30". Cut one end to a point, measuring 7 1/2" from each side to the center bottom.
- 2) Apply Heat n Bond onto the back of the red and blue fabric. Cut 3 large stars from blue fabric. Lay them down the center of the banner. Do not fuse them into position until all designs are in place. Cut the letters U. S. A. from red fabric. An easy way to make thick letters is to draw the letters the size you want and use your pencil or marker to continue to add "thickness" to them as desired. Lay the letters in the center of the stars.
- 3) Cut out small red and blue stars. Lay them along each edge alternating them as desired.
- 4) When all pieces are in position as desired, you can fuse the pieces to the surface.
- 5) Paint the dowel rod white. When dry, glue it along the back of the top edge, 1" from the top of the banner. Fold over the top edge and glue to the back over the dowel. If desired, glue stars to each end of the dowel.
