child's apron, chef hat & bakers tray

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### CHILD'S APRON

#### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 2/3 yd. fabric for apron
- 1/8 yd. contrasting fabric for straps
- Sewing machine
- Iron
- Basic sewing supplies

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. From apron fabric, cut two pieces 21"Hx17"W. At top of apron, measure in 4" on each side and mark. Measure down 9" on each side and mark. Cut diagonally from 4" mark to 9" mark on each side.
2. Using 1/2" seam, sew front and back right sides together around all cut edges of apron, leaving opening in diagonal cut for turning. Trim corners, turn right side out and press.
3. Press each diagonal side under 1" and edge stitch to form casing for strap.
4. For strap, cut 2 pieces 2"x44". With right sides together using 1/4" seam, sew strap together, leaving opening for turning. Trim corners, turn right side out and press. Slip stitch opening closed.
5. From one side, slide strap up through casing then down through the other side.

## CHEF HAT

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 5/8 yd. white fabric
- 1" elastic
- Iron-on letters - optional
- Fusible interfacing
- Iron
- Sewing machine
- Basic sewing supplies

### DIRECTIONS:

1. From white fabric, cut a 22" circle for hat and 5"x22" piece for band.
2. Iron interfacing to band. Using 1/2" seam, sew band together at side seam. Press one edge in 1/2" for facing.
3. On circle and band, mark center, back and sides.
4. Run gathering stitches around circle.
5. Matching center, back and sides, pull gathers to fit and sew hat to band with 1/2" seam.
6. Cut 1" elastic 3" long. Mark 3" on each side of back seam and stitch edges to facing. Turn facing up and slip stitch around band.
7. Iron "CHEF" or child's name to band following manufacturer's directions.

Skill Level: Some sewing experience needed

Approximate Crafting Time: 3 hours for both apron & hat

## KIDS' BAKING TRAY

### SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Ready-to-Finish Wooden tray
- Fabric - red, white
- Cardstock - white, green, blue, yellow
- Decoupage medium
- White acrylic paint
- 1" Brush
- Black Sharpie® pen
- Scissors
- Sandpaper - fine-grit
- Spray varnish - satin
- Star templates - optional

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Basecoat tray white. Let dry. Sand lightly then apply a second coat for good coverage.
2. Cut fabric to exact fit inside of tray. Brush a thin layer of decoupage medium onto tray center. Lay fabric in place and decoupage over fabric. Allow to dry. Repeat several times until you have a protective layer.
3. Cut stars from cardstock and draw stitch lines around their edges. Brush decoupage medium on the backs of the stars, one at a time, and position over fabric. Apply a light coat of medium over each star. When dry, apply another coat of medium over the entire surface.
4. Draw stitch lines on the outside of tray, around the edges as shown.
5. Finish with satin spray varnish.

Skill Level: No experience needed

Approximate Crafting Time: 2-3 hours
