## PECK OF PUMPKINS WALL HANGING

### SUPPLIES:

3/4 Yd. Fabric Traditions Peck of Pumpkins Border Fabric  
1/2 Yd. Fabric Traditions Peck of Pumpkins All over Orange  
Pumpkin Faces  
1/2 Yd. Fabric Traditions Peck of Pumpkins All Over Black  
Pumpkin Faces  
1/2 Yd. Fleece  
1 Spool 5/8" Grosgrain Ribbon  
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat  
Sewing machine  
Iron and ironing board  
Basic sewing supplies

Note: 1/4" seam allowances

### DIRECTIONS:

1. From the border fabric cut a piece 23½" across the border by 13" high, starting 2½" up from the selvage.
2. From the all over fabric cut sixteen 3" squares of each color, centering a face on each square.
3. Starting with an orange square and alternating colors stitch 9 blocks together for the top of the wall hanging, having the faces next to each other. Repeat for the bottom of the wall hanging.
4. Stitch one row of blocks to the top of the wall hanging making sure the faces are in the right direction. Stitch the other row to the bottom.
5. Starting and ending with a black square, stitch 7 squares together vertically so the faces are on top of one another. Repeat with the remaining squares.
6. Stitch one row of squares to each side of the wall hanging.
7. From the remaining border fabric cut 3 tabs 3"x3½". With right sides together fold tab in half along the 3½" side and stitch. Turn and press. Repeat with the other two tabs.
8. Fold the tab in half. Stitch one tab to the top of the front sides of the wall hanging lining up the raw edges of the tab and the top of the wall hanging, 1/4" in from the sides. Stitch the other tab to the center of the wall hanging.
9. Cut a piece from the remaining border fabric and a piece of fleece 28½"x18½".
10. Baste the fleece to the back of the wall hanging.
11. With right sides together stitch the front and back of the wall hanging together leaving an opening at the bottom for turning.
12. Turn and press. Hand stitch the opening closed.
13. Stitch the ribbon on one edge to the front of the wall hanging over the seams, squaring the ribbon on the corners. Stitch on the other edge of the ribbon.

Skill level: No experience needed.



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
