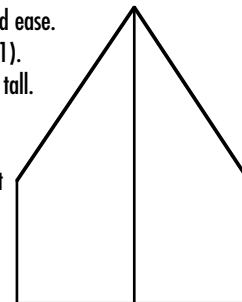
Santa's Hat Chair Back Cover

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- 1½ yd. Red fleece (makes 2 chair covers)
- Basic sewing supplies
- Ruler
- 3 yds. Boa or white fur trim
- Sewing machine
- Pencil
- Red thread
- Pattern paper
- Fabric glue

DIRECTIONS:

1. Measure width and depth of chair back. Add 2" to width for seam allowance and ease.
2. To create pattern: On pattern paper, use width measurement plus 2" (from step 1). 30" high at center"; straight sides at 13" – more if the chair back is particularly tall. These measurements include a 1/2" seam allowance.
3. Use pattern to cut four fleece pieces.
4. With right sides facing each other, sew two hat pieces together along the straight and angled sides. Trim corners and turn.
5. Sew 2" hem at bottom.
6. Glue trim along bottom of hat.
7. For the pompom, cut a 12" piece of boa, fold in half, tie a loose knot, then sew or glue ends of the knot together. Sew or glue pompom to point of hat.

Santa Collar Fleece Robe

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Shawl collar fleece robe pattern
- White boa trim
- Sewing machine
- Red fleece and other supplies listed on pattern package
- 1/4 yd. Fusible interfacing
- Basic sewing supplies

DIRECTIONS:

1. Follow pattern instructions with the following changes.
2. Add 1" to pocket facing and apply fusible interfacing to pocket facing. Before sewing pockets to robe, sew four 1" button holes 1" apart parallel to top edge of pocket.
3. Continue with pattern directions.
4. Sew 1" button holes 1" apart all along shawl collar parallel to edge.
5. Wrap boa trim through button holes and around edge to create the "Santa" trim.
6. Lace, ribbon and other trims can be wrapped for other seasons.

Skill Level: Some sewing experience needed

Approximate Crafting Time: 2-hrs chair back, half day for robe
